Created as benchmark for project and to help shape work

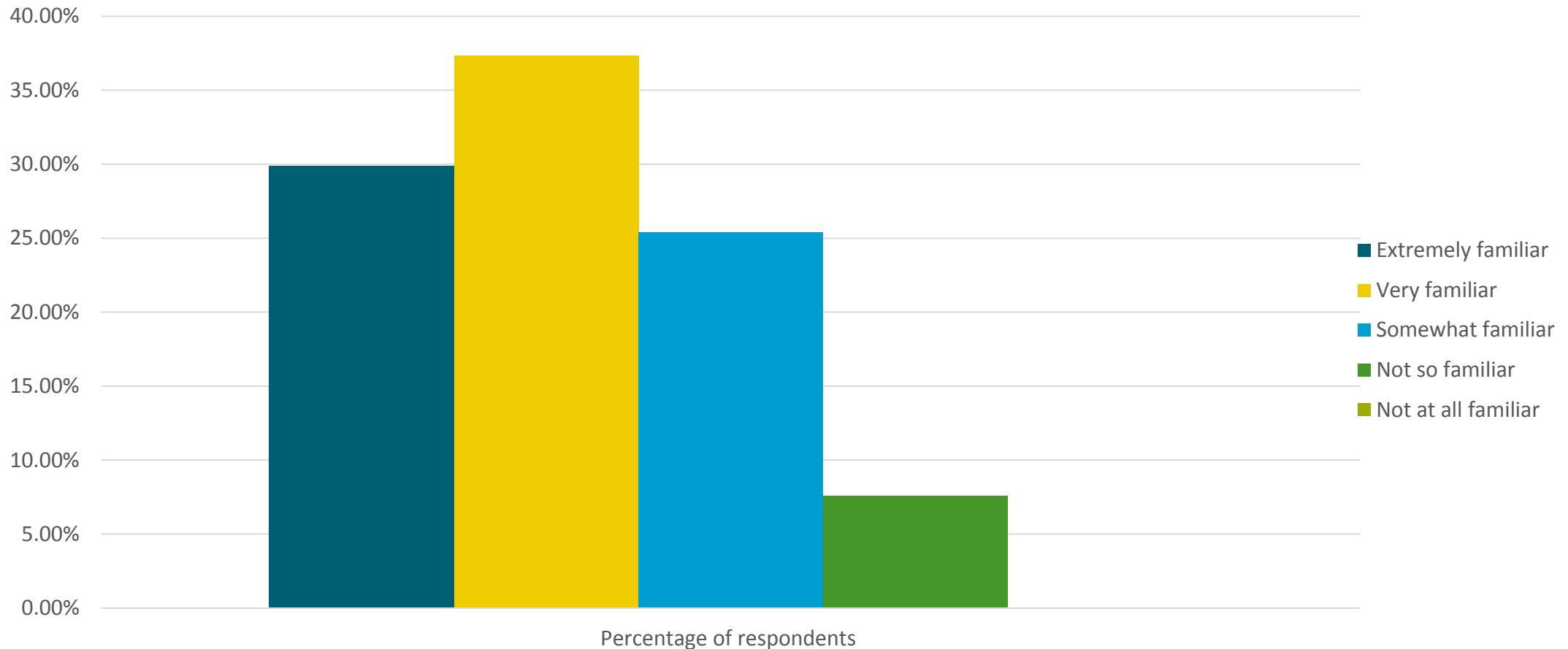
Cascaded to Deans, heads of school and course leads through CoDH news bulletin and Association of Advanced Practice Educators (AAPE)

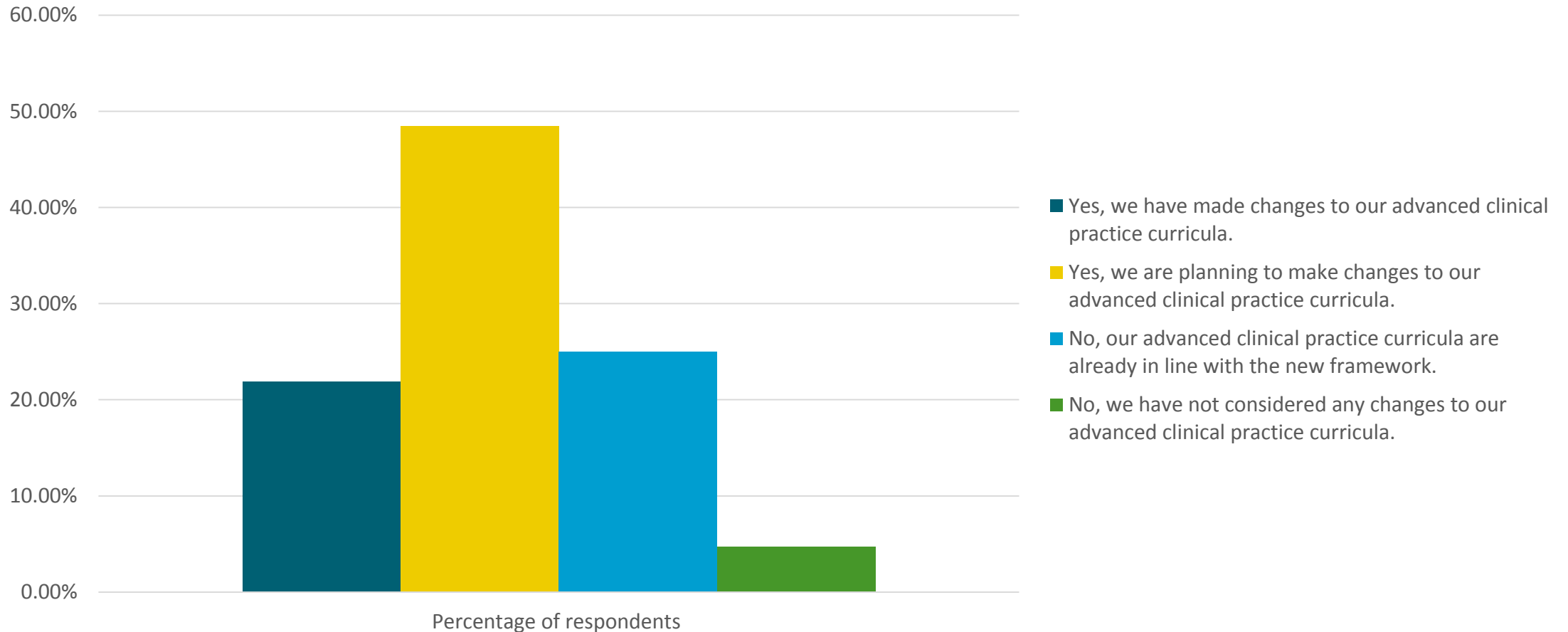
1. How familiar are you with the 2017 Health Education England multi-professional framework for advanced clinical practice?

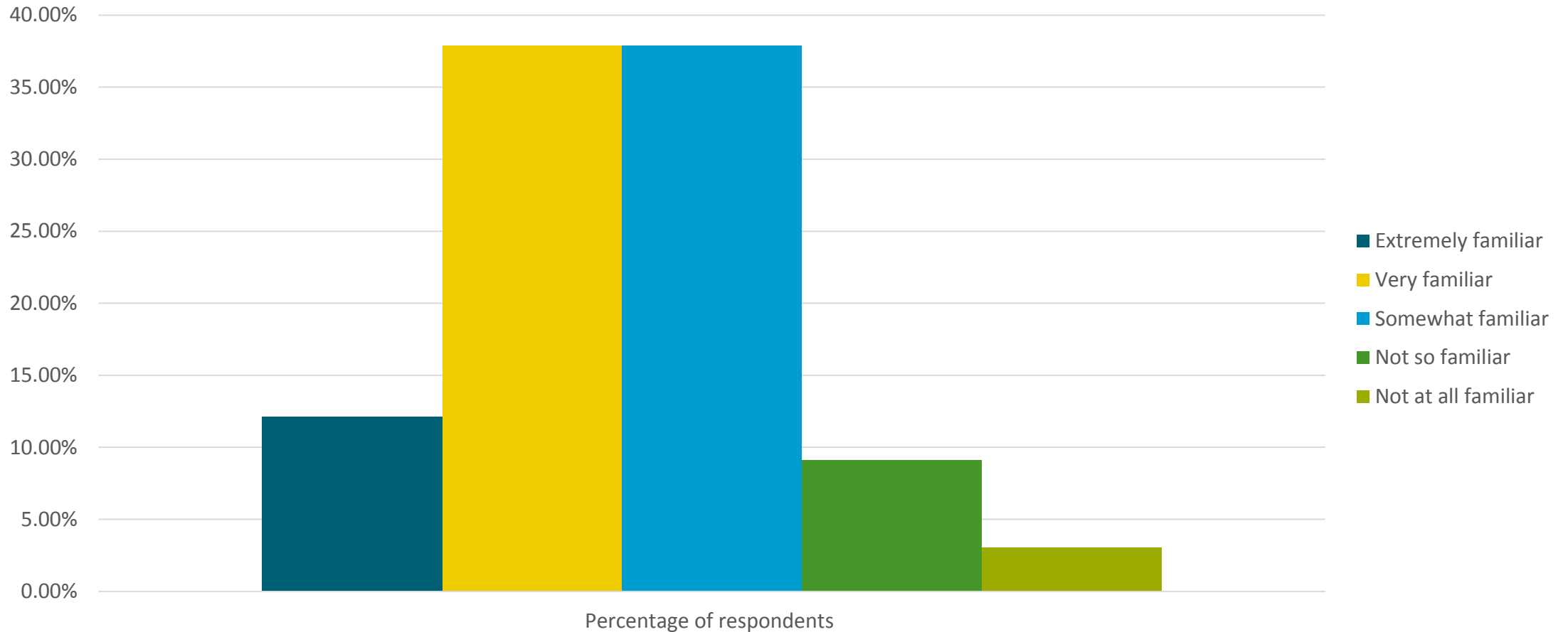
2. Have you made or are you planning any changes to your advanced clinical practice curricula in light of the framework?

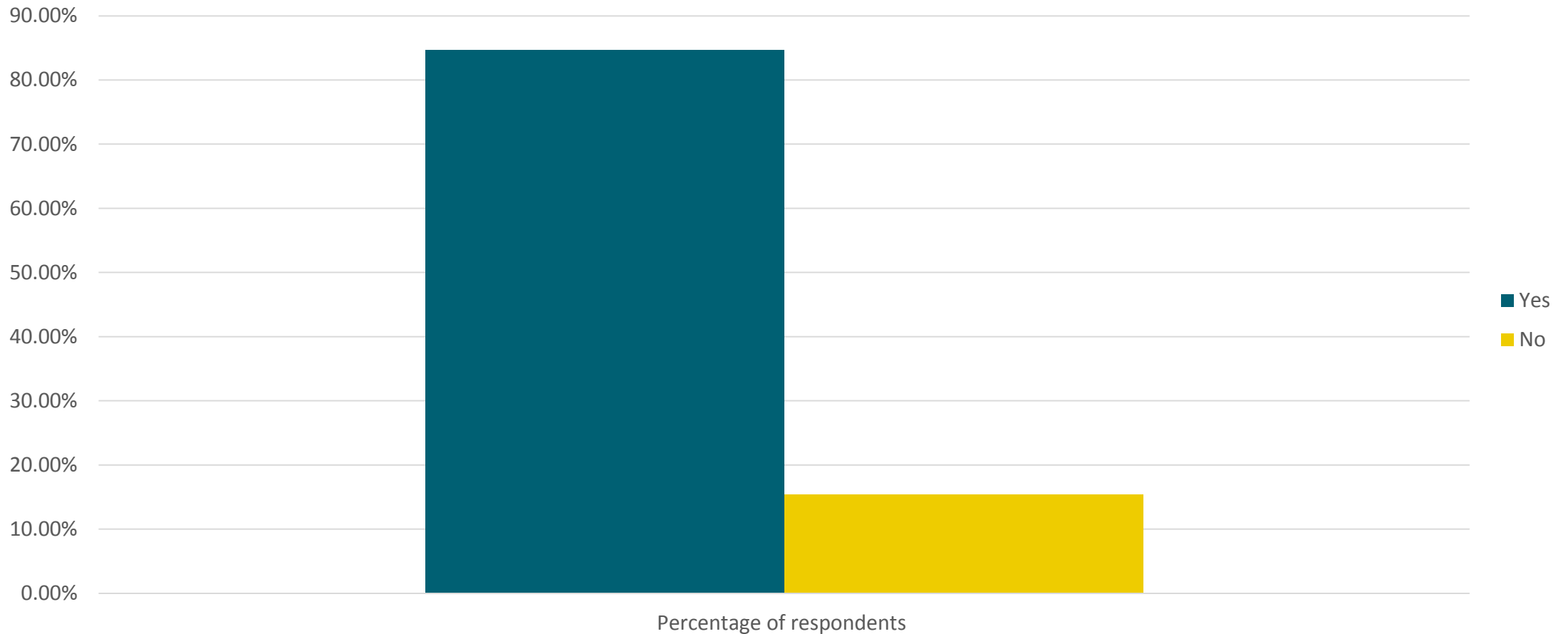
3. How familiar are you with the new advanced clinical practitioner apprenticeship?

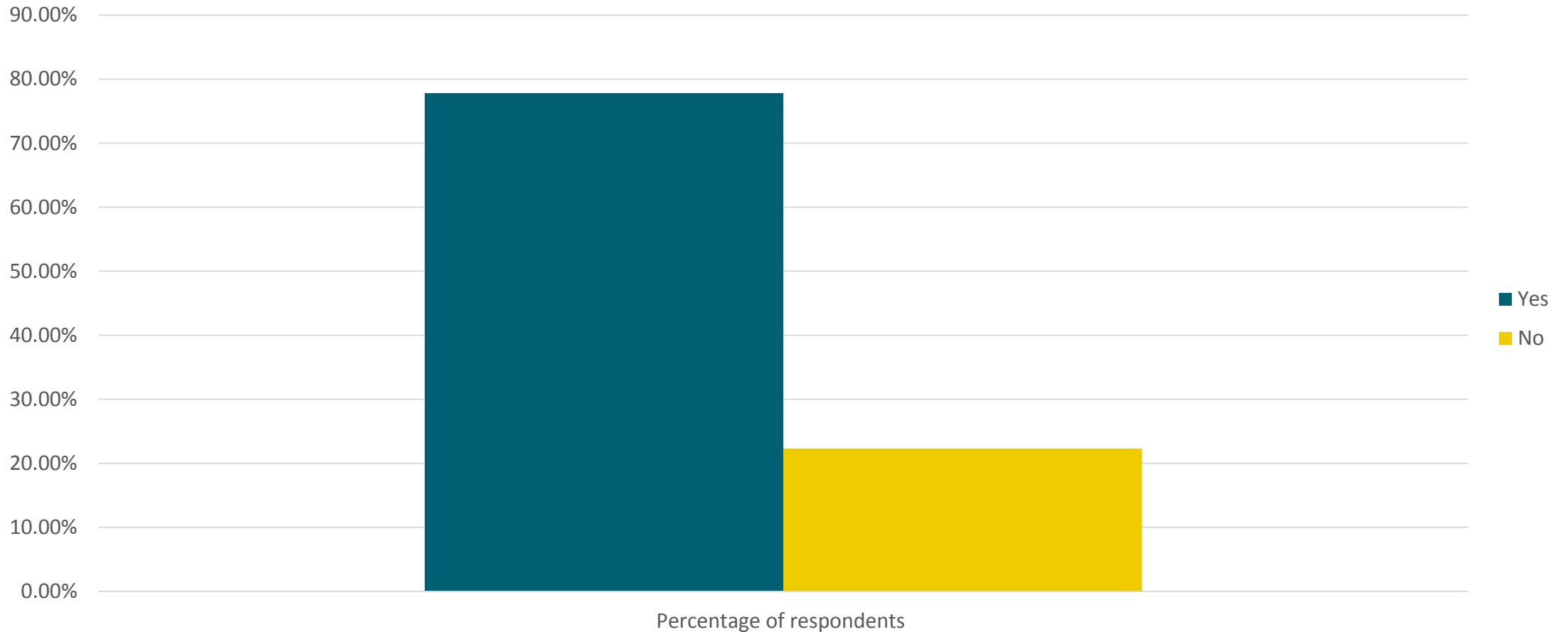

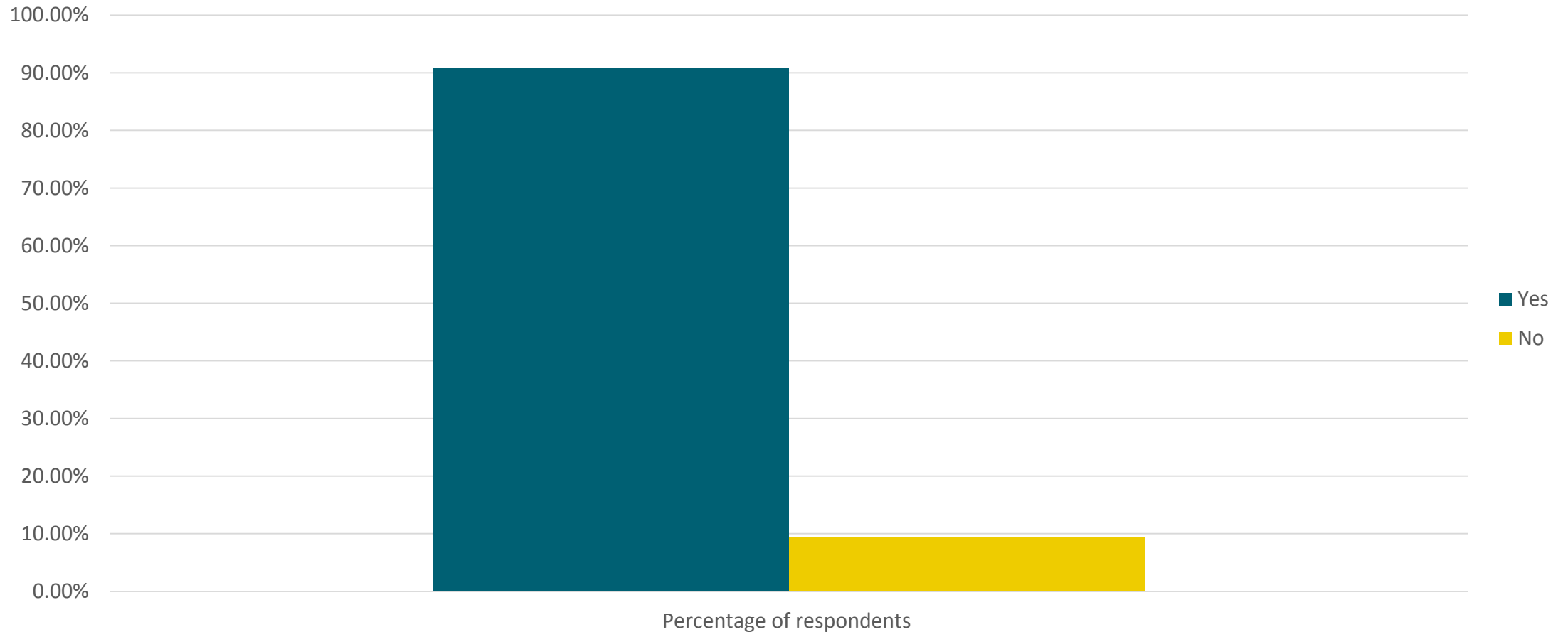

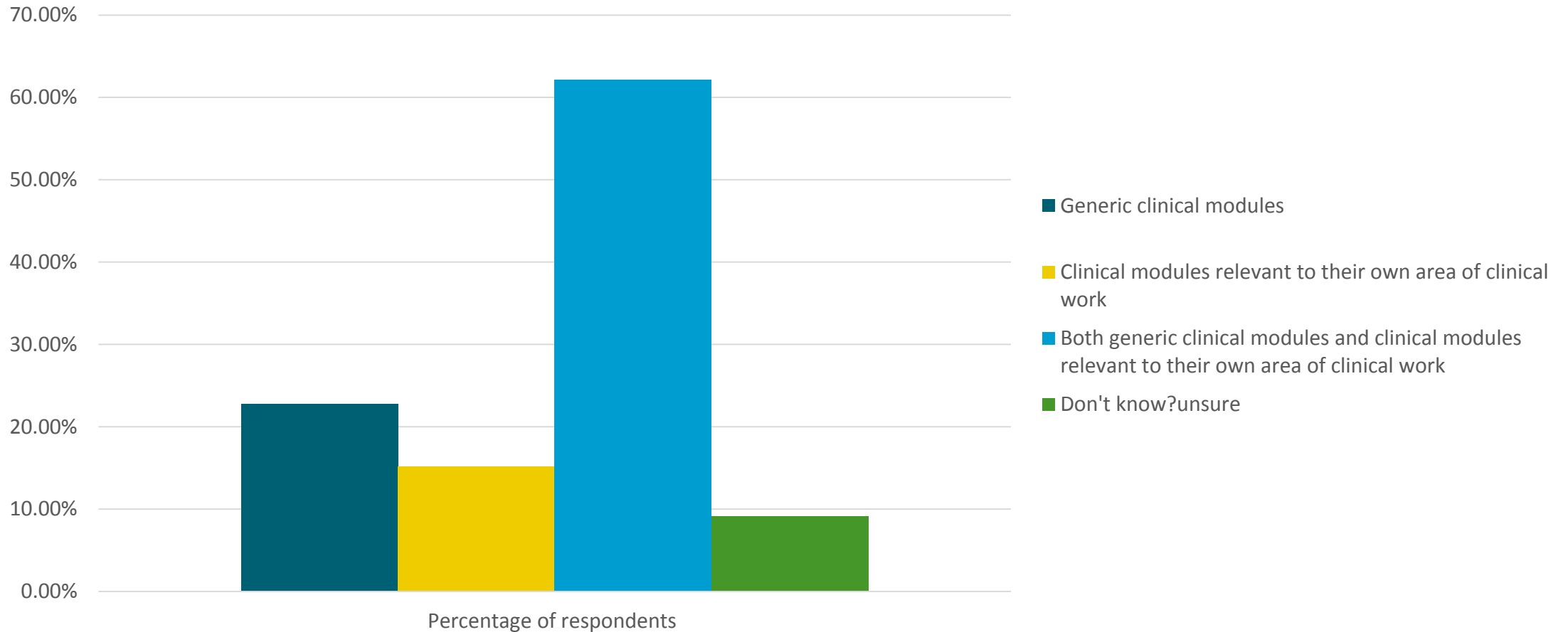

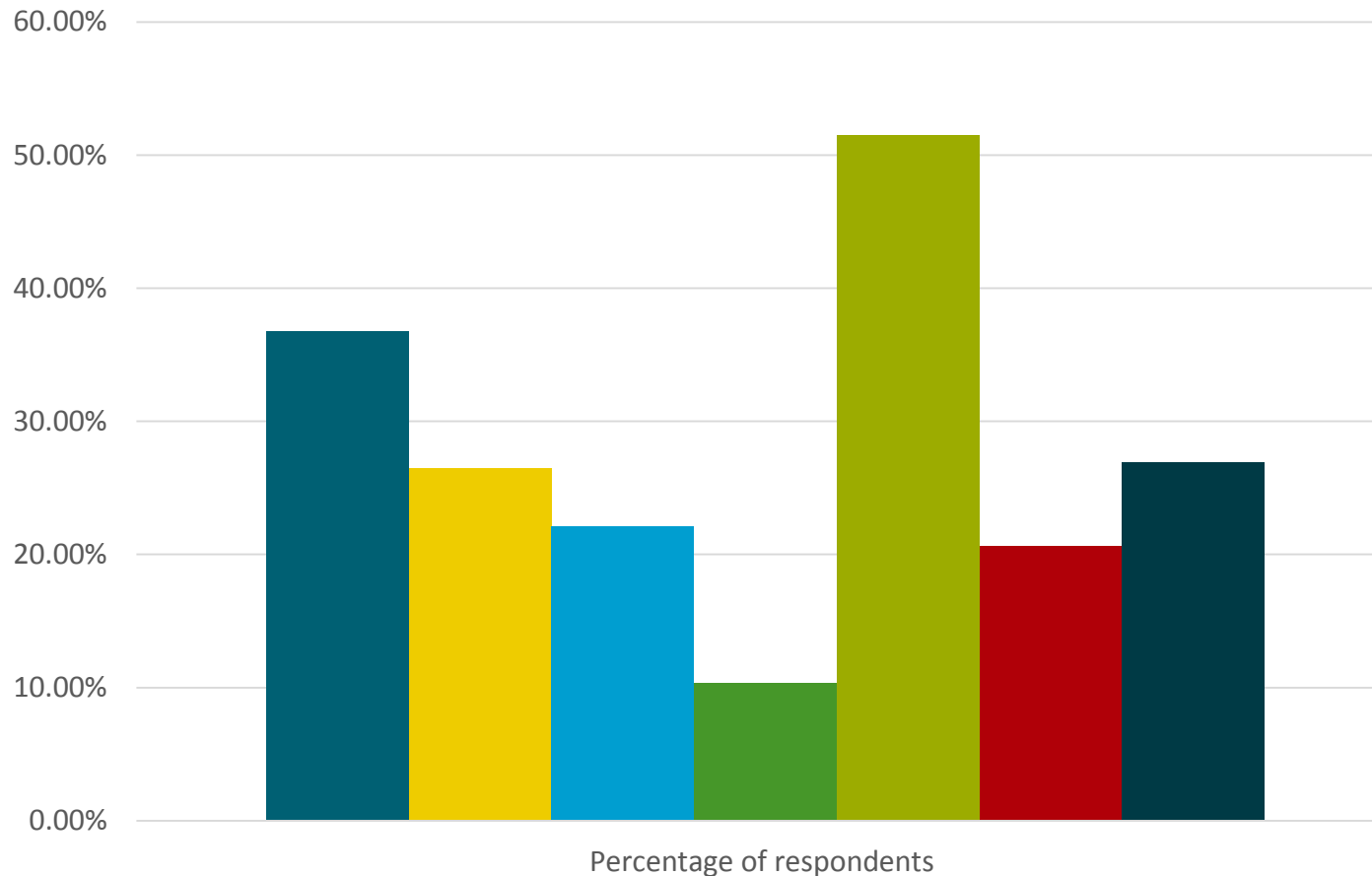
